2. Scope of the Environmental Management Programme

This Environmental Management Programme (EMP), prescribes and directs the management of all environmental aspects, physical, natural and / or social, associated with and arising from construction work undertaken for the proposed upgrading of the Cederberg Tourist Park.

This EMP will commence as soon as the authorisation process is completed and the RoD is received and will end after the final audit report is submitted to DEA&DP as soon as the upgrading is completed. For the operation phase the owners will have to compile and integrated environmental plan that deals with infrastructure-, tourism- and biodiversity management and the management of the remaining portion of the property. This will be a declared contract nature reserve with CapeNature .

For convenience the plan deals with the role and responsibilities of key stakeholders on site, setting the administrative framework, construction phase that describe all environmental issues related to this phase, describe the demolishing of existing infrastructure and provide guidelines for decommissioning.
